Player Code of Conduct

I hereby understand and agree to the following:

- I will abide by the rules, guidelines and policies as set forth by the Nathan Hale Jr Huskies Youth football program
- I must consistently display high standards of behavior as defined by my coaching staff and officials.
- I understand that football is a team sport and that my actions as an individual can and will affect my team as a whole.

It is my responsibility to be a contributing/responsible teammate and leader by:

- ✓ Attending ALL practices and arriving on time
 - ✓ Doing well in school academically
 - ✓ Giving 100% and participating to the best of my ability during games and practices.
 - ✓ Understanding that I may not play my favorite position, but that may be what is best for my team.
 - ✓ Understanding that I may not participate in the game if I do not participate or show up for practice.

- I will be responsible for caring for the football equipment that is issued to me. I will not leave it unattended or disrespectfully throw the equipment on the ground at any time.
 - I understand that if I lose or intentionally damage my issued equipment, I will be responsible for paying for the repair and/or replacement of that equipment.
 - I will always bring all my football equipment to practice and games unless instructed otherwise.
 - I will not use any form of profanity, abusive language, racial slurs, sexual remarks, or obscene gestures (which includes but is not limited to “trash talking” or taunting) of any sort.
 - I understand that when wearing my jersey off the field, I am representing the Jr Huskies and Nathan Hale HS.
 - I will show respect for my coaches, teammates, officials, spectators, opponents, and myself at all times.
 - I will respect the officials and their authority during the games, and I will not argue with the officials no matter the circumstances. The coaches will handle all matters pertaining to the officiating.
 - I will avoid all unnecessary “fooling around” and disruptive behavior during practice and on the sidelines during the game.
 - **I will NOT engage in any unsportsmanlike conduct, physical attack, including but not limited to, the laying of a hand upon, pushing, shoving, striking, or kicking of any teammate, coach, participant, spectator, or team representative on or off the field. Fighting will NOT be tolerated!**

I agree and understand that if I fail to abide by the above rules and guidelines or engage in any other conduct that my coach or the Nathan Hale Jr Huskies Board deems to be detrimental to my team or the organization, I will be subject to disciplinary action which could include but is not limited to the following:

Verbal warning by the coach, official, director or board member of the Nathan Hale Jr Huskies football program.

Game(s) suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file with Jr Huskies football board

Expulsion from the organization as determined by the Jr Huskies football board. All monies will NOT be refunded in whole or part.
